## Face Masks Remain Required in Schools

Although Mayor Bowser recently lifted the city's indoor face mask mandate effective Monday, November 22, local regulations still require that masks are worn by all people, regardless of vaccination status in District schools (as well as in other specific circumstances listed in the mandate). For additional details please reference the mayor's announcement.

#### Children 5 to 11 years old are now eligible to get vaccinated.

The vaccine is safe and lowers the chance of children getting and spreading COVID-19. The vaccine is 90% effective at preventing symptoms of COVID-19. Children will receive a smaller dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine than adolescents and adults, approximately one-third the dose that people 12 and older get.
